The May shoot was a day of great weather, good food and a real nice crowd of shooters (61 shooters-our biggest this year).


This month we tried something a little different, hope all you folks had a good time. Sure was nice to see some of the shooters from 5 Dogs, in Bakersfield, come up and visit us.

down, and the sooner we get those trees planted the sooner we have shade. Everyone try to make it, we need all the help we can get.


