### **Cowboy Logic**

#### **John C. Fremont 1813-1890**

Fremont was personable and handsome, with an aptitude for attracting benefactors—including one who provided a college education and another who arranged a commission with U.S. Topographical Corps. On wilderness expeditions with the Corps, Fremont acquired expert training and a taste for exploration.

Lieutenant Fremont impressed Missouri Senator Thomas Hart Benton, a powerful spokesman for the westward expansion.

Senator Benton and others

interested in the American acquisition of the Oregon country obtained authorization for an 1842 expedition along the Oregon Trail.

Prompted by Benton, Congress authorized a second and far more extensive exploration. Fremont, Kit Carson and 40 others were gone for more than a year, journeying to Oregon, California, the Great Salt Lake, and Santa Fe.

In 1845 President Polk sent Fremont back to California. When Fremont arrived, the Mexican War had begun and the expedition fought in several California skirmishes.

KRR is looking for a few good pards to become posse leaders at the Monthly matches and the Shootout at Fort Miller.


